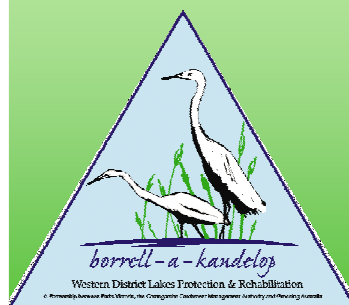

The borrell-a-kandelop project seeks to restore and protect the natural and cultural values of local wetlands. It covers nearly 180,000 hectares and includes nine lakes listed as sites of International Significance under the Ramsar Convention, plus about thirty other lakes and wetlands.



The project also protects habitat for endangered native plants and animals including grasses, herbs, fish, skinks and frogs. The Greening Australia team have focused on revegetation works to control erosion and salinity, fencing to control stock access to lake foreshores, weed and vermin control to reduce competition with and predation of native species and rubbish and pollutant removal to enhance water quality.
